First Semester			
ELS 111	History of the English Language	3.0	This course is designed to explain the external (historical, political, cultural forces) and internal (changes in the language features) histories of the English language.
ELS 112	Intro to English Language	3.0	This course explains the nature and essential features of language. It provides an overview of the phonological system, morphological system, syntactic system, and semantic system of the English language. It gives an introduction to discourse as well as language acquisition and language change.
ELS 113	Theories of Language & Language Acquisition	3.0	This course explains the theories of the origin of human language and of language acquisition and development.

Second Semester			
ELS 121	Foundations of English Language Teaching and Learning	3.0	This course introduces the theories and principles of English language teaching informed by knowledge of language acquisition and learning processes.
ELS 122	English Syntax	3.0	This course centers on the analysis of structures of phrases and sentences in English language.
ELS 123	English Phonology and Morphology	3.0	This course deals with the patterns and systems of sounds and the structure and formation of words in the English language.
ELS 124	ELT Approaches and Methods	3.0	This course evaluates traditional and current approaches and methods of English language teaching.

SECOND YEAR			
First Semester			
ELS 226	Technical Writing in the Profession	3.0	This course provides the theories, principles, and practice of technical communication across professions.

ELS 211	Semantics of English	3.0	This course deals with the meaning of words, phrases and sentences in the English language.
ELS 212	Intro to Language, society & culture	3.0	This course examines language as it is used in real-life social contexts. More specifically, this course provides an introduction to anthropological linguistics which offers a set of concepts and tools for undertaking the study of language, society, and culture.
ELS 213	Language of Literary Texts	3.0	This course introduces various approaches to the study of different literary genres.

ELS 221	English Discourse	3.0	This course focuses on the study of spoken and written English above the sentence level.
ELS 223	Language of Non-Literary Texts	3.0	This course introduces various approaches to the study of non-literary texts.
ELS 225	Computer-Mediated Communication	3.0	This course discusses the social and linguistic features of various forms of texts brought about by information and communication technology.
ELS 222	Intercultural Communication	3.0	This course analyzes information shared across different cultures. As an interdisciplinary field of study, it exposes the students to verbal and non-verbal communication, communication styles, interpretation as well as values shared across various social settings.
